Sub:- Circulation of pamphlets to general public to prevent house breaking, house theft, M.V.Theft and snatching – Reg.

➤ **HOUSE BREAKING & HOUSE THEFT.**

- i) Always switch on the outside light of the house during night.
- ii) Even if out of home/town, one inside light should be switched on 24 hours.
- iii) Always identify visitors before opening door.
- iv) Beware of persons coming to your house under pretext of repairing / selling things, etc.
- v) Inform your neighbors / local police about your absence from your house for long / short periods.
- vi) Install magic eye / pee hole /safety chain on door.
- vii) Don't keep huge amount of cash / ornaments in house, use bank lockers for the same.
- viii) Ensure police verification of your domestic help / driver /watchmen / Tenant, etc.
- ix) Keep-in touch with Beat Officer use 100 no, in case of any emergency.
- x) Inform police if any stranger/suspicious person found wondering in your locality.

➤ **M.V. THEFT.**

- i) Ensure twice that vehicle is properly is locked, before leaving the parking area.
- ii) Use additional lock for enhanced safety of the vehicle.
- iii) Always use available parking facility, if no such parking is available park at place where more number of vehicles already parked.
- iv) Don't park vehicle at any isolated place, Park at well lit, CCTV installed areas.
- v) Try to park vehicle at places where lots of people passing through area.

Parents to avoid handing over vehicle to young children who may not take due care while parking the vehicle.

SNATCHING:

- i) Avoid venturing into isolated / dark / street.
- ii) Try to remain ⁱⁿ group while walking, wherever possible.
- iii) While walking alone cover the jewels by your saree/ scarf especially while walking in market area / using public transport / crowded places.
- iv) Always suspect and beware of strangers offering / asking any kind of help/favour.
- v) Use artificial /imitation jewellery wherever possible.
- vi) Beware of bikers especially youngsters as rider and pillion.
- vii) Always shout for help in the event of snatching and inform immediately to local police for quick response.

2. CIs/SHOs are instructed to include any suggestions/points, if any, and translate it to Tamil version. The Tamil/English version should be circulated to general public in the form of pamphlets, pasting stickers in autos and business establishments, slide shows in cinema theatres, through local cable network, putting hoardings in important junctions, etc. A compliance report in this regard should reach to the undersigned on or before 29-10-2013.
