

It has been experienced that functioning of Control Room is not upto the mark. The staff is not aware of their duties and responsibilities and reponse to the public calls is also not coming forth. In fact, the entire set up of Control Room, its equipments and surroundings needs restructuring under Modernization Scheme. We are getting enough money for modernization of police but we had hardly paid attention to modernize our Control Room. In other states like Delhi and Chennai Control Rooms, they have done remarkably well in this regard and we may also take advantage of their advancement and follow their good practices. Similarly CCR patrolling and response time and feed back is also not found to be very effective and useful. We hardly come across any good work done by them and a large number of staff is working without any significant output.

With a view to have a effective and modernized Control Room as also to improve response time and outputs of CCR staff, the following Committee is constituted to give their suggestions for this purpose, so as to reach to the undersigned by 5th of September 2006.
