

OFFER OF APPOINTMENT

The undersigned hereby offers Thiru g. Baskaran, . . . . . a temporary post of Sub-Inspr. of Police in the Police Department Pondicherry on a pay of Rs.1640/- in the scale of Rs.1640-60-2600-SB-75-2900 plus usual allowances.

The appointee will also is entitled to draw dearness and other allowances at the rates admissible under and subject to the conditions laid down in rules and orders governing the grant of such allowance in force time to time.

2. The terms of appointment are as follows:-

- i) The post is temporary but it is likely to become permanent. In the event of its becoming permanent, his claims for permanent absorption will be considered in accordance with the rules in force.
- ii) The appointment is purely provisional pending the satisfactory completion of the training and period of probation. The candidate is required to execute a bond that if he fails to complete the training and the probation satisfactorily he will have to refund to the Government all the expenditure incurred on his training including the pay and other allowances and TA/DA etc. received by him during the period of training.
- iii) The appointment may be terminated at an time by one month's notice given by either side, viz., the appointee or the appointing authority without assigning any reasons subject to the appointee being liable to refund all the expenditure as indicated in (ii) above if the termination occurs on his request. The appointing authority also reserves the right of terminating the services of the appointee forthwith or before the expiration of the stipulated before of notice by making payment to him of a sum equivalent to the pay and allowance for the period of notice or the unexpired portion thereof.
- iv) The appointee shall be a member of the Pondicherry Police Force recruited under and governed by the provisions of the Police Act 1961 and shall be liable to serve in any part of the country.
- v) Other conditions of service will be governed by the relevant rules and orders in force from time to time.

3. The appointment will be further subject to:

- i) Production of a certificate of fitness from the Competent medical authority (viz., Medical Board/Civil Surgeon/R.M.O.).


- ii) Submission of a declaration in the prescribed form and in the event of the candidate having more than one wife living or having married to a person having more than one wife living the appointment will be subject to his being exempted from the enforcement of the requirement in this behalf.
- iii) Verification of character and antecedents.
- iv) Production of the following original certificates and establishing there from that the candidate fulfils the prescribed minimum qualifications:
  - a) Education and other technical qualifications.
  - b) Marks sheet of his final degree.
  - c) Certificate of age.
  - d) Character certificate in the prescribed form.
  - e) Certificate in the prescribed form in support of candidate for claims to belong to a Scheduled Caste/Scheduled Tribe/ Ex-Service personnel.
- v) Production of 3 copies of his recent passport size photograph duly attested on the back of it by a Gazetted Officer to be the photograph of the candidate as follows:-

4. If any declaration given or information furnished by the candidate proves to be false or if the candidate is found to have wilfully suppressed and material information he will be liable for removal from service and such other action as Government may consider necessary.
5. If Thiru. S. Baskaran . . . . . accepts the offer on the above terms, he should report before *the S.P (H.Q) Pondichery* on or before *8.7.91* If the candidate fails to report for duty in the prescribed date, the offer will be treated as cancelled.
6. On joining duty he will immediately undergo a training and probation for periods prescribed in the relevant Recruitment Rules.

7. The period of his probation is likely to be extended if his progress is not found to be satisfactory.
8. No travelling allowances will be allowed for joining the appointment.
