C I R C U L A R

Prisoners are released from prisons on parole for various reasons. It is the primary duty of the Station House Officers to monitor parolees on a daily basis and report any violations immediately to the senior officers. Therefore, it is imperative to issue clear instructions for dealing with parolees. Accordingly, the following instructions are hereby issued and shall be scrupulously followed by all Police Officers and Men working in the Police Stations, without fail.

1. The Station House Officer (SHO) shall ensure that the parolee reports to the police station as directed as specified.
2. The police shall verify that the parolee resides only at the permitted address and does not leave the jurisdiction without prior written permission.
3. Regular supervision shall be maintained to ensure that the parolee:
 - o Maintains good conduct and peace
 - o Does not involve in any criminal or unlawful activity
 - o Does not contact victims, witnesses, or co-accused, if prohibited
4. Reporting & Monitoring :
 - * A daily/periodic report regarding the parolee's conduct shall be entered in the station General Diary.
 - * Any suspicious behavior, breach of conditions, or violation of parole terms shall be immediately reported to The Superintendent of Police concerned, and The prison/jail authorities
5. In case of violation of any parole condition, the parole shall be treated as liable for cancellation. The police shall take immediate steps to secure the parolee and produce him/her before the competent authority or return him/her to the prison, as per law.
6. On completion of the parole period, the Station House Officer (SHO) shall ensure that the parolee surrenders to the concerned jail authority on time, and a compliance report shall be forwarded the Supdt. of Police.
7. The Superintendent of Police (ARS) Shall supervise the parolee and ensure that the accused does not establish any contact with associates or co-accused
