NOTE

As per the instructions of our Respected DGP, the following steps have been initiated to preclude the drowning incidents at Puducherry beaches by the Coastal PS, Puducherry.


- Warning sign boards have been installed in all the beach areas in order to create awareness among the public.
- All the fishermen panchayathats have been requested to pass information regarding swimming attempts of the tourists.
- Government/Private Beach Resort authorities have been instructed to post life guards for conducting rescue operations and also instructed to impart their inmates on the nature of the local beach areas and water depth.


Besides, all the beaches of Puducherry Region have been brought under the screening of Coastal PS, Puducherry and costal police personnel have been positioned in beaches with available life saving equipments where the drowning incidents are frequent and the beat officers and men have been instructed to keep stringent vigil to achieve the task.

Though, the rate of downing incidents is decreased, beyond our tremendous efforts, such accidents are still existing. Hence, it is requested to direct the SHOs concerned to disseminate suitable instructions to their beat officers and beat police personnel to practice extra vigil over the beach areas in addition to the routine beat duties for making our beaches become drowning incident free zone please.
