Sub: FIREWORKS LICENCE – grant of licence for temporary shops – timeline fixed by the Government of India for the receipt of applications and disposal – reg.  
Ref: Letter No. R.4(1)57/VI(Vol.VIII) dt.05.05.2016 and corrigendum dated 16.05.2016 Issued by the Chief Controller of Explosives, Government of India, Nagpur.

We submit that there was a misconception in the minds of the District Magistrates / Police Commissioners about the validity period of licences for the temporary fireworks shops. The Chief Controller of Explosives, Government of India, Nagpur has now clarified vide above referenced letters ( copy enclosed ) the validity period of licence as 30 days instead of 15 days and he has also issued a timeline for receipt of application and grant of licence thereof as given below:

Receipt of applications seeking grant of temporary fireworks licenses in Form LE-5	At least 60 days before Diwali
Period for which temporary licenses are to be granted for sale of fireworks from shops	For a period of 30 days before Diwali
Issue of sanctioned licences / or sending intimation thereof, to the licensees	Sanctioned licences shall be issued or intimations sent to licensees well in advance of the licence period.

We are glad to note that the Delhi Police have taken a proactive initiative in accordance with the above timeline fixed for the issuance of the licences to the temporary fireworks shops and publicised it in the news papers and in their website also ( copy enclosed ).

We, therefore, earnestly request you to kindly issue proper direction to all Commissioners of Police who are empowered to issue licences to the temporary fireworks shops under the Explosives Rule 2008, to comply with the above guidelines and ensure that the "ease of doing business" is really created in India.

Sub: Sensitizing the District Authorities regarding grant of Form LE-5 licence for temporary shops for possession and sale of fireworks during festivals as per rule 84 of Explosives Rules, 2008 - reg

Dear Sir,

Smt. Nirmala Sitaraman, Hon'ble Union Minister of State, Commerce & Industry, New-Delhi had visited Sivakasi on 19.2.2016 and heard grievances of fireworks industry. During her visit, Tamil Nadu Amorges & Fireworks Manufacturers Association [TANFAMA] Sivakasi had raised a grievance to the hon'ble Minister that there is a delay in grant of licence in Form LE 5 (licence for temporary shops for possession and sale of fireworks) during festival as per rule 84 of Explosives Rules, 2008 by the District Authorities. Such licences are granted just three days before Deepavali and due to this the licensees face difficulties in transportation, uneven distribution and dumping of fireworks thus risking the public safety.

In view of the above, you may kindly direct the District Authorities in your State to grant licences atleast 15 days prior to Deepavali and they may also receive applications for grant of licence 45 days prior to Deepavali and advance intimation regarding grant of licences may also be given to the applicants.


