NOTIFICATION

The Hon'ble Supreme Court of India in their Judgement dated 22nd September 2006 in Writ Petition (Civil) No.310 of 1996 titled Prakash Singh & Others Vs. Union of India and Others had inter alia issued directions to Central Government/State Government/Union Territories to Constitute a Police Establishment Board which shall decide all transfers, postings, promotions and other service related matter of officers of and below the rank of Deputy Superintendent of Police.

2. Accordingly, the Lieutenant-Governor, Puducherry is pleased to constitute the Police Establishment Board comprising of the following members:-

Police Establishment Board

Inspector General of Police	-	Chairman
Deputy Inspector General of Police	-	Member
Assistant Inspector General of Police	-	Member
Senior Superintendent of Police (L&O)	-	Member
Senior Superintendent of Police (Karaikal)	-	Member
Additional Senior Superintendent of Police (C&I)-	-	Member

3. (a) The Police Establishment Board shall meet from time to time whenever necessary to decide all transfers, postings, promotions and other service related matters of Police personnel of and below the rank of Deputy Superintendent of Police within the Union Territory of Puducherry, excepting those matters which are covered by statutory rules For Deputy Superintendent of Police and above officers of U.T. cadre, the functions of transfers and postings etc. Outside the Union Territory shall be decided by Ministry of Home Affairs.

(b) The Board is authorized to make appropriate recommendations to the State Government regarding the posting and transfer of officers of the rank of Superintendent of Police. The Government is expected to give due weight to these recommendations and shall normally accept them.

(c) The Board shall also function as a forum of appeal for disposing of representations received from Police personnel regarding promotion/transfer/disciplinary proceedings or other orders.

(d) The Board shall generally review the functioning of the Police in the State.
