Decision is recorded to the creation of 14 posts in Police Department, Pondicherry under No. 127 as detailed below for posting of security guards at All India Radio Station, Pondicherry and I.V. relay centre, Orimedu for a period of one year with effect from the date of commencement till 30.2.53 or till the necessity therefor ceases whichever is earlier:-

2. Decision is also recorded to the repositioning of the incumbents of the posts created in para (1) above to the above institutions. During the period of repositioning, the personnel will draw their grade pay, applicable to para plus usual allowances at the rates in force from time to time. The posts shall automatically stand abolished when the staff are no longer required by the institution.

3. The deputation is subject to the condition that the leave salary and pensionary contributions should be recovered from the above institution on the scale which will be fixed by the director of accounts and the Series, Pensionary and communicated to the above institution separately. The payment of I.A. and C.A. and transfer -A. if admissible shall be regulated in accordance with the provisions contained in the A.Rs and S.Rs and the expenditure should <sup>be</sup> borne by the above institutions.

4. During the period of deputation, they will be entitled to the benefits of medical attendance rates as per the rules in force under the Administration and the expenditure should be borne by the above institutions. The expenditure on supply of uniforms, on account of usage of arms and ammunitions etc. will be recovered from the above institutions. The above institutions should also bear the whole expenditure in respect of any compensatory allowances for the period of leave in or at the end of foreign service and also pay the leave salary charges in respect of any disability incurred in and through foreign service even though such disability manifests itself after the termination of foreign service. No additional pensionary contribution shall be recovered in respect of the period of disability.

5. The above personnel will remain subject to leave rules applicable to the service of which he is a member. Postal interest will be levied <sup>307</sup> under ~~rule~~ if payment of leave salary or pension is delayed. Pension and leave salary contributions shall be credited under the relevant receipt head in the budget.

6. The above institutions should deposit at the nearest treasury an amount equal to three times the pay and allowances

of the officials. The deposit will be accounted for as "Revenue Deposit" and refunded to them after the expiry of the period of employment of the officials and after the claim of the Department and the officials have been settled.

7. The pay and allowances of the personnel accommodated against the posts created in para (1) above shall be debited to the relevant head in the budget of the Police Department.
