Photographs/images, if any, shall be of **high-resolution quality** with accurate captions

The contributors whose articles are approved for publication will be entitled to an **honorarium of ₹3,000/- per article**, as approved by the competent authority in CBI. Therefore, the contributors shall furnish the following details along with their articles:
