In exercise of the powers conferred by section 432(1) and section 433 (b) of the Code of Criminal Procedure 1973 (Central Act No.2 of 1974) read with rules 286, 329, 330, 331 of the Puducherry Prison Rules, 1969 and also as per the recommendations of the Advisory Board constituted in pursuance of the G.O. second read above, the Lieutenant Government of the Union Territory of Puducherry is pleased to grant premature release of the following life convict prisoners on old age ground by remitting the remaining portion of sentence:-

Sl.No.	Name of the life convict prisoner	Court in which convicted
1.	Sathiya @ Sathiyamoorthy S/o Ramalingam (Convict No.1241)	Convicted by the Hon'ble Principal Sessions Judge, Puducherry in SC.No.20/2003 dated 25.09.2016 and confirmed by the Hon'ble High Court, Madras in Criminal Appeal No.587 of 2004 dated 20.01.2007 and confined in the Central Prison, Puducherry on life imprisonment. He has completed 14 years of imprisonment on 02.04.2016.
2.	Mishel @ Ramesh S/o Hendry @ Devadas (Convict No.0599)	Convicted by the Court of Hon'ble III Additional Sessions Judge, Puducherry in SC No.45/2001 dated 08.01.2002 and confirmed by the Hon'ble High Court, Madras in Criminal Appeal No.221&336 of 2002 dated 21.06.2005 and confined in the Central Prison, Puducherry on life imprisonment. He has completed 14 years of imprisonment on 26.03.2016.

2. The Advisory Board has recommended for the premature release of the above said life convict prisoners.

3. The above premature release is subject to the following conditions:-  
(i) The above life convict prisoners shall report to the Station House Officer of the respective Police Stations on first day of every month.  
(ii) The above life convict prisoners shall be under supervision of Station House Officer of the respective Police Stations.  
(iii) They should not associate with bad characters or lead a dissolute life. They should be of good behaviour and should not commit any offence. They should ordinarily reside in the respective Police Station limits and shall not leave the area without permission from the Station House Officer.

4. They are ordered to be set free forthwith subject to strict observance of the conditions stipulated.
