Dear Shri Krishnaia,

Medical Council of India has been entrusted to regulate the standards of medical education in the country. In the recent past, there has been growth of private medical colleges in which the faculty as well as the infrastructure, at times, are not as per the Medical Council of India norms. Various such scams which were investigated by the CBI and other State Agencies also indicate that standard of faculty members as well as infrastructure in these private medical colleges were not as per MCI regulations. As such, several well wishers, individuals and concerned citizens' complaint about poor infrastructure, fake faculty members and cheating/duping of the students by the management of private medical colleges etc.

It is imperative that such complaints/allegations are to be promptly verified and investigated, however, Medical Council of India has very small set-up of vigilance and limited manpower to investigate such complaints. Although MCI does carry out surprise inspections, however, it is seen that such colleges cover up these shortcoming during the inspection and the state of affairs remains the same after the inspection is over.

Although, we do refer such cases of serious nature/allegations to CBI, however, it is felt that State investigating agencies (CID/ Anti-corruption/vigilance/E.O.W wings of the State Police) could help us tremendously in verifying/investigating such allegations throughout the length and breadth of the country.

MCI would be forwarding such allegations, which are serious in nature, to the State Investigating Agencies with request to investigate/verify and for taking prompt action, as often, the alleged offences occur in the jurisdiction of the States/UTs.

I request that such kind of requests made by the MCI may kindly be honoured by the state agencies.
