Ref: Coordination with merchants of Big Bazaar

As directed by SSP (L & O), Puducherry, the meeting with the selected members of Big Bazaar Market running various groups of business was conducted in the office of the undersigned today on 18.09.13 between 1200 to 1500 hours.

The various issues pertaining to the Big bazaar were discussed and the merchants are requested needy action on the following:-

1. Need to establish drinking water supply and lighting arrangement in the Market.
2. Security Cameras need to be installed at the 13 entry / exit gates of Market.
3. The foot path / floor of the Market got totally damaged and immediate attention is required for re-flooring as everyone is facing heavy hardship to walk down.
4. The path way in the market goes highly encroached by the Path-way vendors.
5. Vendors need more parking place.
6. During Sunday markets, public parking their vehicle / bike on the middle of the MG Road between Rangapillai Street and Nehru Street at M.G. Road causing heavy disturbance to the business.
7. The general publics are parking their vehicle on the path-way of market entry gates and causing obstructions to others to get into the market.
8. During early hours between 3.00 A.M. to 6.00 A.M, the outside wholesale fishermen are unloading their fishes on the MG Road to conduct their sale to retailers but not cleaning the road leaving abundant the fish waste. This caused more stringent smell and the shop keepers could not able to do their business during day hours. Including fishing retailers of the market everyone jointly requesting to prevent the same.
9. With regard to "Mamul" within the market, no one had expressed a clear picture. However, indirectly informed about curry leaf vendor one Arumugam and some others.

In general, all were advised to develop confidence on their own strength supported by Police. Openness and unity within the various associations of markets should be strengthened which will automatically deter the outsiders /criminals to intervene into their business. It was requested to lodge specific complaint to initiate legal action within the legal frame which otherwise will boost the activities of criminals and mischief mongers.

Based on the discussion with Merchant association, Commissioner of Puducherry Municipality was approached and the same was briefed in detail for speedy remedy. As agreed by commissioner, the site inspection with Municipal commissioner is scheduled on 29/09/13.
