Sub: Minutes of Security review Meeting - Submission - Regarding.

Ref: Shopkeepers and Footpath vendors in & around JN Street GB PSL.

As advised by the DGP and SSP(L&O), CLG meeting with the members of Shopkeepers and Footpath vendors in & around JN Street of Grand Bazaar PSL chaired by SP (North) at Hotel Abiramu Residency, Anna Salai, Puducherry was conducted on 09.1.2013 between 1700 and 1930 hrs. During the meeting a brief introduction are given on the important of the security review and its mutual benefits. Members of the meeting were requested the following.

1. **Auto-stands at all road junctions and their double layer parking** become heavy traffic hazard. Apart from this misbehavior by some auto drivers if requested to move the auto. Requested necessary action by both Traffic, RTO & Local Police.
2. **Periodical checking License / RC book for all autos & its drivers at all auto-stands** including their place of residence to be carried out by RTO / Traffic and local Police. This will contain playing of theft autos.
3. **Highlighting the alternating bay parking system** followed in Bangalore, it was requested to implement the same at Nehru Street. Accordingly the parking of 2 / 3 / 4 wheelers vehicle on **Right and Left side road bay alternating** on every day or every week or every month basis as deems fit. This will protect the common interest of all traders / shopkeepers.
4. It was also requested to try for **2 / 3 wheeler parking on one side** and the **4 wheeler parking on the other side** at Nehru Street.
5. **Enforcement for one-way** to be monitored properly as it regularly violated at all roads.
6. **Parking lot / bay developed on the Big Canal at Gingee Salai** is not still implemented while shops are being developed violating the common interest for which it was developed.
7. It was requested to demolish the old jail to develop the best dedicated fully **automated multilayer parking system**.
8. **Demanded to renovate the existing Police Booth** at Anna Salai near Ananda Inn. Traders extended their willingness to support financial assistance.
9. With regard to demand on **mamool**, Shop keepers expressed their readiness in giving the complaint, if any.
10. **Recently more number of bunk shops** are being developed on all platform, this as to be contained and to be regulated in a discipline manner.
11. **The small vendors and servants of shops** used to park their vehicle in Nehru Street throughout the day occupying the place, which obstructed others parking. In this regard, they should be instructed properly to utilize the **New parking yard at old Jail premises**.
12. **Each and every small vendors** running business in platform should be respected by others.


13. Not to allow any vehicle in Nehru Street to violate **ONE-WAY** even between 2200 to 0730 hrs.
14. PWD workers left the road with pits covered by sand causing traffic obstructions should be restored.
15. Frequent call on Bandth caused much inconvenience. As there is no insurance cover for damages due to bandth etc all are scared to open shops. Hence request police intervention.
16. Demanded Traffic Police physical presence between 0700 to 0900 Hrs / 1600 to 1800 hrs at Anna Salai & 45 feet road junction to regulate traffic.
17. Glass dealer shop at the junction of Anna Salai & 45 "road throughing his broken glass pieces garbage along the bus stop area in-front of his shop causing dangerous hazard. Request police intervention.
18. **Speed breakers** along **French School Lycee Francee** near **Government Hospital** and its primary school.

SP(N) intervened and informed that all necessary measures will be adopted through respective authorities and will liaise with SP(Traffic). Apart from this, he had advised the members on the followings

1. To install the CCTV camera at every shop covering the road side and parking area.
2. CCTV footage of the respective shops corroborated by the CCTV footage of neighbouring shops will help to counter their difficulties during police recovery of properties of crime by producing the video clippings of their shops and corroborate with neighbour CCTV cameras.
3. Posting of private security for every shop or group of shops with special attention to night hours
4. Seven days seven lock system for each shop
5. Preventive measures against crime on attention diversion either by showing money scattered on road or any other.
6. To avoid platform encroachment with general exception up to one foot from the shop, this will include the accommodation of the platform vendors.

The Merchants, leaders, representatives were highly convinced on the various discussions held and they expressed their willing and interest to cooperate with Police and other machineries of legal systems to build better secured society.
