MINUTES OF THE ANTI-RAGGING COMMITTEE MEETING HELD ON 4TH DECEMBER 2012 IN THE CHAMBER OF COLLECTOR, PUDUCHERRY.

The Meeting of the Anti-Ragging Committee (ARC) for Puducherry Region was held on 4-12-2012 at 12.30 noon in the chamber of Collector – cum – Chairman Anti-Ragging Committee for Puducherry Region, Saram, Puducherry. The following members were present:

1. Thiru. S. Ramaraju - Superintendent of Police (North) Puducherry.
2. Dr. M. Varadarajan - Medical Superintendent Mahatma Gandhi Medical College & Research Institute, Puducherry.
3. Dr. Mahadevan Professor – Academic / Dean i/c School of Medicine, JIPMER., Puducherry.
4. Dr. Vak. Venkatachalapathy - Principal Manakula Vinayagar Engineering College, Madagadipet.
5. Dr. S. Nagarajan - Pondicherry Engineering College Pillaichavady.
6. Thiru B. Dhandapany Senthil College of Education, ECR., Lawspet, Puducherry.
7. Dr. E.M. Rajan - Principal Tagore Arts College, Lawspet, Puducherry.
8. Dr. S. Varalakshimi - Principal Bharathidasan Govt. College for Women, Puducherry.

At the outset, the Director of Higher & Technical Education-cum-Member Secretary (ARC) welcomed the members and briefed about the meeting. The copy of the UGC Regulations On Curbing The Menace Of Ragging In Higher Educational Institutions, 2009 and the Notification of AICTE for Prevention and prohibition of Ragging in Technical Institutions were circulated to all the members. The Committee was informed that the Anti-Ragging Monitoring Committee has been formed in all the Colleges and the anti-ragging instructions have also been displayed on the Notice Board of the Colleges for strict adherence of the students. In some Colleges, Undertakings have been obtained from each and every student duly counter-signed by their parent. The Committee was also appraised the reports received from all the Principals that no incident of ragging has been reported in the College till date. After deliberations, the following decisions and observations were made by the Chairman (ARC):

- ARC meeting should be conducted one month before starting of Colleges every year.
- Medical Colleges like JIPMER, where students from various States studying, are forming groups and some problems are created during the time of cultural programmes and other occasions. Such cases should be dealt with very strongly by the College administration and suitable disciplinary action should be initiated immediately.
- Interaction between the senior students and the junior students should take place in the Colleges right from the admission till December which will create a conducive atmosphere among the students to develop friendship.
- To invite Senior Police Officers for the introductory lectures to the students at the time of re-opening.
- Anti-Ragging Monitoring Committee in the Colleges should function the entire academic year to monitor the activities of the students. Any serious matters should be immediately reported to the police for immediate action.
- To convene the next meeting of ARC in the month of July 2013.

The meeting was ended with vote of thanks.
