MINUTES OF THE MEETING HELD ON 15.10.2012 AT 3.30 PM IN THE CHAMBER OF THE DISTRICT COLLECTOR, PUDUCHERRY REGARDING REMOVAL OF UNAUTHORIZED HOARDINGS/ BANNERS, FLEXBOARDS ETC.

A meeting was held in the chamber of the District Collector-cum-District Magistrate on 15.10.2012 at 3.30 PM regarding removal of unauthorized digital banners, flex boards, cut-outs, Hoardings etc. The following officials participated in the meeting:-

At the outset, the District Collector welcomed the officers and expressed concern that the removal of unauthorized hoardings was being carried out only at his intervention in the form of special drive which should have been done by the Local Bodies as a matter of routine. The following are the actionable points as discussed in the said meeting. :-

- a) Unauthorized Hoarding, banners etc. should be removed from 24.10.2012 by the LAD/PWD with the assistance of Revenue and Police authorities. The District Collector will issue a press release appealing the public concerned to remove the unauthorized hoarding immediately and to avoid any legal consequences.
- b) Periodical compliance report on the removal of unauthorized hoardings should be furnished.
- c) The Commissioners of Local Bodies/PWD should lodge complaints for filing FIRs against the deserving/repeated offenders.
- d) The LAD/PWD authorities should issue necessary instructions to the owners/runners of Marriage halls/community halls that no banners, cut-outs, flexi-boards etc., should be erected in the premises of Marriage halls/community halls during any functions/ceremonies.

The meeting came to an end with vote of thanks for the Chair.
