MINUTES OF THE MEETING HELD ON 25.10.2012 AT 1600 HOURS
IN THE CHAMBER OF IGP

A meeting was convened by IGP to review the Action against rowdies, Action under Goondas Act & Pending investigation cases. DIGP (Admn), SPs North / South / CID, all CIs in Puducherry District, Inspectors of STF North / South / Rural and Inspector CRB were attended the meeting.

The following are the important observations / instructions at the meeting:-

I. Action against Rowdies:

- While discussing the cases booked under sec.294 IPC, SP (North) informed that this section will be applied only to normal people and not on rowdies. As and when the police stations are receiving complaints, cases will be booked under sec. 294 IPC to avoid any further problems.
- CIs/SHOs should initiate action to take the criminals under police custody in respect of property related offences.
- FIR is the permanent document of Police Station and this document must remain in the station itself permanently. While discussing the procedure being followed in writing of FIRs, it was informed that In future, the FIR booklet should be printed in triplicate (1+2) only. CRB & SPs concerned may be supplied with photocopies.
- While perusing the inspection notes of North / South / Rural sub divisions, IGP informed that the CDs have not been written in many cases. All CIs and SHOs to ensure that instructions of the inspecting officers are strictly complied with. All SPs / CIs are instructed to ensure the compliance of the previous inspection notes.
- It was informed that 26 cases of murder have been reported this year upto September 2012. Out of which, 25 cases were detected and one is yet to be detected. SPs concerned shall submit a detailed note about the status of these cases by next week. As the cases of robbery have shown increase compared to last year, the CIs and SHOs to see that this crime remains under control and to ensure detection of all unworked out cases.
- ⊙ It was instructed that cases be booked under sec. 363 IPC in respect of missing children below the age of 16 years.
- Further, IGP expressed his concern over the low detection of hurt cases since the percentage of detection is 74% when compared to last year of 82%. More than 150 hurt cases are still lying undetected. It was instructed that all these cases should be detected.
- Similarly, the detection of burglary cases also needs to be improved. Out of 44 burglary cases, only 14 have been detected so far. Concerted efforts should be made to look out these cases.
- SPs were instructed to conduct special drive to recover stolen properties. It is high time that the Puducherry Police show some tangible result on this. Every CI should gear up their staff.
- SP (Traffic) was instructed to focus on over speed driving, rash driving, removal of sun control film on cars and drunken driving and overloading of buses, etc.
- The study of cases registered under sec. 354 IPC should be carried out by the SSP/L&O and submit report about the age, rural / urban, financial status of the victim and make some preventive strategy.
- 23 cases of rioting are yet to be worked out. SPs should discuss with SSP (L&O) and see that these cases are worked out early.

- All CIs were also instructed to reconcile the crime data with CRB.
- With regard to disposal of U.I. cases, it was seen that the pendency shown by the CRB is very high. It was instructed that CIs concerned should prepare a list of cases charge sheeted, yet to be taken on file by the Court and pending trial in the Court and submit the same within a week's time.
- PCR vans are supposed to show their presence at the conspicuous places and they should reach the accident place in time to take the injured to the nearest government hospitals. If required, the services of 108 ambulance be utilized.
- Continuous search in the houses of grave criminals should be conducted and compliance be sent to this office.
- While reviewing the performance of Special Task Force, it was instructed that the Inspectors of STF North / South / Rural should submit a list of work done for the last 6 months within a fortnight.

II. Goondas Act:


- Detailed discussion was held on action taken against rowdies under Goondas Act. Only one order was issued out of 17 proposals sent to Government. Draft proposals for another 5 cases in North, 2 in South and 1 in Rural sub divisions are being prepared and it will be sent to Government soon.
- IGP instructed that criminals should be identified and don't keep the criminals in the background. It was further instructed that process of documentation be started for submission to the Government and this should be done continuously. All CIs should brief the SHOs and start the process 24x7 and should act professionally.
- Out of 459 old criminals / history sheeters, it was instructed to identify the potential trouble makers and have surveillance over them.
- With regard to action under Sec.144 CrPC, IGP instructed in particular that if any of such criminal violates the orders of the SDM, the concerned CIs should initiate suo motto action under Sec.188 Cr.PC.

III. Petitions:

- A large number of petitions are pending in the Police Stations for a long time. All those pending petitions shall be investigated within the stipulated timeline and entire report be submitted and not in part.
- It was instructed that SP/PCR shall send replies for the petitions relating to SC/ST, NHRC, etc. after getting approval of IGP.

Compliance on the above points be carried out by the concerned officers and a report be sent to this office by strictly adhering the timeline.


