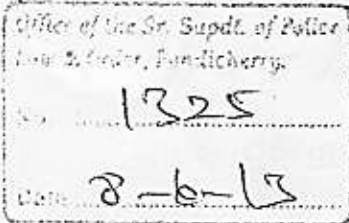

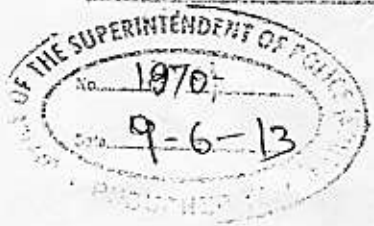

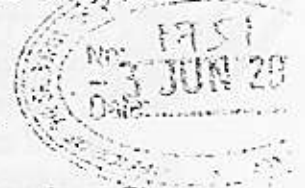

Sub: Observance of 26th June 2013 as 'International Day against Drug Abuse and Illicit Trafficking' – regarding.

The UN General Assembly in a Resolution passed in December, 1987, proclaimed 26th June of each year as the "International Day against Drug Abuse and Illicit Trafficking". In pursuance of this declaration, every year, 26th June is observed all over the world to raise public awareness regarding menace of drugs and mobilize support for drug control.

2. 'Think Health not Drugs' is an ongoing theme/campaign of the United Nations Office on Drugs and Crime (UNODC).

3. The fast changing social milieu is mainly contributing to the proliferation of drug abuse (both traditional and new psychoactive substances) especially among the youth population. The onus is on our law enforcement agencies to not only undertake preventive work by apprehending drug traffickers but also to sensitize the masses against the pernicious effects of drug abuse. It is, therefore, requested that necessary directions may be given to all the Heads of the Anti Narcotics Task Force and other agencies engaged in enforcement and drug abuse control to organize various programmes on 26th June, 2013. The Programmes could include the following:-

- Awareness programmes in schools, colleges and slum areas
- Anti drug marches/Runs/Rally
- Public meetings in areas and among target groups vulnerable to drug abuse and HIV (Street Children, Jail inmates, Truck drivers, Slums etc)
- Seminars on drug abuse in training institutions
- Workshops to evolve new coordinated strategies for supply reduction and demand reduction by the various enforcement agencies/ NGOs
- Exhibitions on drug abuse in different cities and towns,
- Flashing of SMS through various service providers
- Wide publicity by way of displaying and distribution of banners, posters, pamphlets, hoardings, slide shows in cinemas etc

4. I would like to further suggest that the activities to be organized by the various Departments/Agencies on the occasion of 26th June, may be celebrated continuously for a fortnight, as in most of the states, schools and colleges remain closed on 26th June due to summer vacation.

5. The Narcotics Control Bureau would highly appreciate a feedback on the different programmes organized in various Districts, State Police HQrs and by the ANTF of the State on the International Day against Drug Abuse and Illicit Trafficking.
