CIRCULAR

Wearing of helmet while driving a two wheeler is mandated by Law and subsequent rules notified by the Government. The Government has recently amended the Motor Vehicle Act with stringent provisions for effective enforcement to control the increasing number of road accident deaths happening in the country. In line with the recently amended Motor Vehicle Act, Government of Puducherry have notified enhanced fines for traffic offences vide G.O. Ms. No.02/Tr.Sectt./2021, Dated.28.01.2021 and authorized Officers of the Police, Transport and Revenue Departments to impose spot fine on violators. Now, riding a two wheeler without wearing a helmet will attract a spot fine of Rs.1,000/- and lead to suspension of Driving License for three months.

All Police personnel and Ministerial staff of Puducherry Police Department are therefore directed to wear helmet while riding a two wheeler irrespective of being in uniform or in civvies, while on duty or otherwise, riding Government vehicle or private one. Non wearing of helmets would not only attract penalty as prescribed under section 194(D) of MV Act but also disciplinary action.
