NOTIFICATION

In exercise of the powers conferred by the proviso to article 309 of the Constitution of India, read with the Notification No. F. 5/4/65-GP., dated the 1st January, 1965 of the Ministry of Home Affairs, Government of India, New Delhi and in partial modification of the Home Department's notification issued in G.O.Ms.No.53, dated 28th May, 1982, published in Supplement to the Gazette No. 23 of 28th June 1982, the Lieutenant-Governor of Pondicherry, hereby makes the following rules further to amend the rules regulating the method of recruitment to the Group 'C' and Group 'D' posts in the Police Department, Government of Pondicherry, namely:—

1. *Short title and commencement.*— (1) These rules may be called the Government of Pondicherry, Police Department Group 'C' and Group 'D' Posts Recruitment (Amendment) Rules, 2002.

(2) They shall come into force from the date of their publication in the official gazette.

2. *Amendment of the Schedule.*— In the Government of Pondicherry, Police Department Group 'C' and Group 'D' Posts Recruitment Rules, 1982,—

(i) For the existing Schedule-II, the following schedule shall respectively be substituted, namely:—

SCHEDULE-II

RECRUITMENT RULES FOR THE POST OF SUB-INSPECTOR OF POLICE

1. Name of the post.	Sub-Inspector of Police.
2. Number of posts.	123 (One hundred and twenty-three) (2001).
3. Classification.	Group 'C' (Non-Gazetted-Non-Ministerial).
4. Scale of pay.	Rs 5,500-175-9,000.
5. Whether selection post or non-selection post.	Selection.
6. Age limit for direct recruits.	Between 20 and 27 years.
7. Educational and other qualifications required for direct recruits.	(a) Graduate from a recognised University or its equivalent; (b) Physical standard, physical efficiency and medical standards as prescribed in the Standing Order issued by the Inspector-General of Police with the approval of the Government.

8. Whether age and educational qualifications prescribed for direct recruits will apply in the case of promotees.

9. Period of probation, if any.

Two years.

10. Method of recruitment, whether by direct recruitment or by promotion or by deputation/transfer and percentage of the vacancies to be filled by various methods.

By promotion/direct recruitment in the ratio of 1:1. Direct recruitment shall be done through a written test. Only those who fulfil the physical standards, pass the physical efficiency test and the medical examination shall be eligible to appear for the written test. The details of written test shall be prescribed through Standing Order issued by the Inspector-General of Police with the approval of the Government.

11. In case of recruitment by promotion/deputation/transfer, grades from which promotion/deputation/transfer is to be made.

From regular Assistant Sub-Inspector of Police with minimum 3 years of continuous service, failing which Head Constables with 6 years continuous service in the post, and who have passed the prescribed Departmental tests.

12. If a Departmental Promotion Committee/Recruitment Committee exists, what is its composition?

Departmental Promotion Committee/Recruitment Committee for Group 'C' Posts consisting of—

- 1 Chief Secretary ... Chairman
- 2 Inspector-General of Police ... Member
- 3 Under Secretary (Home) ... Member

13. Circumstances in which Union Public Service Commission is to be consulted in making recruitment.

14. Remarks.

The measurement of physical standard and the conduct of physical efficiency test and medical examination will be done as per the Standing Order issued by the Inspector-General of Police with the approval of the Government of the Union territory of Pondicherry."
