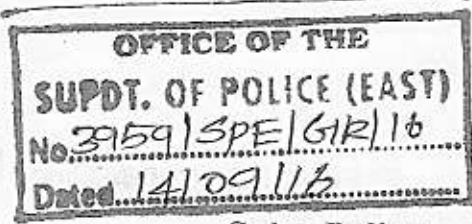

**Subject:-** Deployment of Special Mahila Police Volunteers (MPVs) – safety and security of women - regarding

Sir/Madam,

Please refer to the D.O. No. WW-13/5/2015-WW dated 31<sup>st</sup> May, 2016 from Secretary, Ministry of Women and Child Development to all States/UTs on the scheme for deploying Special Mahila Police Volunteers (MPVs) for improving the safety and security of women. The Special Mahila Police Volunteers will be educated women of the locality and will be selected by the District Superintendent of Police through a transparent process, after inviting applications. They will also be given training regarding their work at district level.

2. The SMPVs are intended to be an interface between the public and the police, who can be approached by women in distress for seeking assistance and support. The MPVs are envisaged as empowered, responsible, socially aware women for fostering leadership in local settings to facilitate police outreach on gender concerns. The broad mandate of MPVs is to report incidences of violence against women such as domestic violence, child marriage, dowry harassment and violence faced by women in public and private spaces. She will act as a role model for the community. The guidelines have also been forwarded by Secretary, Ministry of Women and Child Development vide letter dated 31<sup>st</sup> May, 2016 for consideration.
