Subject: Traffic arrangements in connection with Deepavali Festival – some important instructions – Regarding.

Since the Deepavali festival is fast approaching, lot of public will be visiting shopping areas for purchasing various items for the festival. Hence, there is a likelihood of traffic congestions in all the important streets, viz., J.N. Street, Ambalathadayar Madam Street, Rangapillai Street, Anna Salai, C.S.Pillai Street, Bharathi Street, M.G. Road, Mission Street, etc. Hence, it is instructed that the Traffic Police shall make necessary arrangements in these streets to maintain the vehicle parking in such a manner that free flow of traffic is ensured. It was discussed with SP(PAP) to spare additional men and he has assured to spare about 10 PCs of PAP from 08.10.2011 onwards for utilizing during evening hours, till the end of the festival.


2. SP(Traffic) and Inspector (Traffic) shall contact the organizers of NSS/NCC immediately to contribute volunteers to regulate traffic in the evening hours, particularly between 1700 hrs and 2200 hrs. All the Traffic Wardens shall be utilized only for regulating the traffic in these areas. While discussing with SP(Traffic), he has mentioned that the shop owners are parking their vehicles in these streets for the whole day causing obstruction for the movement of public. Hence, it is instructed that SP(Traffic) and Inspector (Traffic) will talk to the concerned shop owners of these streets and ask them to park their vehicles at some other streets, where the traffic congestion is less and come to their shops by walk, so that public can enjoy their shopping during the festive season. SP(Traffic) will also identify certain temporary parking areas where the vehicles of the shop owners can be parked till the deepavali festival.

It is also pertinent to mention at this juncture that during Deepavali season, many new vendors will try to occupy the platform/road areas of the main thoroughfares for their business affecting traffic, which shall be dealt with strictly. It is not only the traffic Police, but also the local Police should ensure free flow of traffic in their areas. They should be more vigilant to ensure that incidents like chain snatching, pick pocketing, etc. are averted in their areas. The SHOs will personally make patrolling in their areas during the peak hours to inculcate confidence in the minds of public and the CIs/SPs will monitor the same.
