SVP National Police Academy, Hyderabad is organizing a 3- days Course on '**Social media analysis & setting up of social media Labs**' from 11-13 March, 2019 for the Police officers of the rank of Asst. Superintendent of Police to Inspector General of Police. This course is part of the initiatives taken by the Academy to develop domain expertise on a particular subject among the IPS officers of the Country under the Visiting Faculty Programme. The Course will be delivered by Shri Ponnurangam Kumaraguru, Associate Professor (CSE), IIIT, Hyderabad.

2. The objectives of the Course are:-

- To enable the participants to do basic analysis of data collected from Social Media.
- To enable the participants to develop a report on a given situation from Social Media.
- To introduce participants in use of Application Programmable Interface (API) to collect data from Social Media.
- To give exposure to participants to basics of python, access token, Mango DB, JSON, CSV Graph API, etc.

4. **The nominations for the course may please be sent to the Academy latest by 4th February, 2019** through Fax (040-24015179) /E-mail (seniorcourse@svnpa.gov.in) for acceptance and forwarding joining instructions to the nominated officers directly. **The postal address, telephone / mobile number, fax number & E-Mail ID of the nominated officers along with their batch seniority may also be intimated.** Letter for inviting nominations can also be seen at the Academy web site: www.svnpa.gov.in

5. The course is residential and the participants of the course will be staying in the accommodation provided by the Academy. **The expenditure to be incurred on boarding and lodging of the participants shall be met by the Academy.** However, the expenditure on account of travel of officers for attending the course may be borne by the respective State /Central Government Department. It is informed that as per SOP of the Academy, those officers against whom criminal case, DE/PE etc. is in currency or contemplated are **not eligible** to undergo any training programme/course /seminar/workshop at the Academy. Hence, nominations of eligible officers may be sent accordingly.

6. A list of Officers who had given their willingness to **develop domain expertise in 'Cyber Crime & IT'** is enclosed herewith as **Annexure-A** to this letter. It is requested that while nominating Officers for above-said Course, the **DGs may give preference to these Officers from their respective States/UTs.**

7. The dress order for the course participants is formal civvies i.e. shirt (full sleeves), Trouser & tie for gentlemen and Salwar Kameez / Saree / Business suit for ladies.

8. **The nominees may be advised to proceed for the course only after receiving confirmation of acceptance of their nominations from the Academy.** The officers nominated for the Course are required to report at the Academy by the evening of **10th March, 2019** i.e. one day before the commencement of the course. Transport from Hyderabad Airport / railway station to the Academy and back will be provided by the Academy as per travel plan provided by the participants.
