Sir/Madam,

Kindly refer to this Department's letter of even No. dated 28.08.2018 on the subject cited above. Department of Personnel and Training has been organising Mid-Career Interaction between the Armed Forces and Civil Services Officers in collaboration with the Ministry of Defence for the last many years. The basic objective of this programme is to provide exposure of IAS/IPS/IFoS and other civil officers to the military to meet unforeseen situations at short notice. Such interactions are likely to benefit both the Armed Forces and Civil Services officers by mutual learning from each other's strengths and also by imbibing the best points of each other's work culture, ethos and customs. This, in the long run, is expected to help them combat future challenges to national security in a better manner.

As per the Calendar, the third Mid- Career Interaction Programme on the theme of "(a) Civil-Military Interface to tackle threat of terrorist attacks to military installations & infrastructure and (b) Unified intelligence" is scheduled during 12-14 February, 2019 (3 days) at College of Air Warfare- Secunderabad (Hyderabad).
