Sub : Agreement with BSNL on connectivity of Police Stations and Higher Police Officers.

With reference to the above subject, you are aware that CCTNS is in the advance stage of execution. The project envisages connectivity with all the Police Stations and higher Police Officers in the country which are more than 20,000 in number.

2. As per the approved policy, the connectivity shall be done by the BSNL with the cooperation of the SI (System Integrator) and State DIT of your State. This is to inform you that we have recently signed an Agreement with the BSNL to this effect costing Rs. 227.82 crores (inclusive of taxes). Of this, Rs.161.37 crores should be borne by MHA and Rs.66.45 crores shall be borne by DIT, Government of India. The MHA component shall be routed through you and the DIT, Government of India component shall be routed through DIT of the State. Copy of the Agreement is attached for your information.

3. Mode of Connectivity : The mode of connectivity is a mix of four different technologies offered by the BSNL. Primarily the connectivity should be on SWAN network in your State. Those Police Stations/Higher Officers which cannot be connected by SWAN network then they may be connected on VPNoB. Where VNPoBB is not possible, then, WIMAX and finally the VSAT option should be explored in that order. Previously letters to you have already been sent by NCRB and by us to conduct a survey in consultation with BSNL and State DIT to find out which Police Stations/higher Police Officers can be connected through which technology.

4. Payment to BSNL : This connectivity is for a period of 3 years from the date on which the State Nodal Officers sign the SLA with the local circle of the BSNL. Copy of the draft SLA is enclosed (The draft SLA is annexed to the Agreement). The cost will depend on the number of police Stations connected through each of the above four technology options. Therefore, you must quickly finalize the survey and then work out the cost payable by the State to the local BSNL. The fund payable by the MHA will be sent to you and the same shall then be paid by you to the local BSNL office after satisfying the conditions of the SLA Agreement in consultation with the SL.

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5. What CCTNS Nodal Officers should do?

- (i) The Nodal Officer must immediately sign the SLA with the State BSNL.
- (ii) For the above purpose, a survey must be completed and an approximate cost should be quickly ascertained.
- (iii) SI should be immediately on board so that connectivity is ensured smoothly. It may be noted that if the State fails to select SI by the end of November, 2011 then the whole connectivity process may be severely delayed.
- (iv) Nodal Officers may immediately get in touch with the State DIT and find out the status of SWAN network so that the Police Stations you have identified for SWAN network may be connected under that network immediately.
- (v) A signed copy of SLA may be sent to this Ministry.
