**Subject: CCTNS Core Application Software (CAS) Delivery for Study - reg**

Dear Sir,

As you are aware, Core application Software (CAS) under CCTNS project is in advanced stage of development and final software along with documentation would be shared with all the States/UTs by end of December 2011. Meanwhile, Software development Agency (SDA) has shared a preliminary version of CAS i.e. CAS Lite, (Offline version), containing some of the functionalities, of the services to be provided by CCTNS CAS. Objective of this version of CAS is to bring familiarization of the software to Police Personnel and SI selected in your State/UT but this version is not for customization and implementation purpose in States/UTs. The final CAS software containing all functionalities i.e. all the twenty six services, of all three versions viz. CAS - Microsoft Stack, CAS - Open Source Stack and CAS Offline version would be provided to all States/UTs by end of December 2011 along with complete documentation would be delivered to all the States/UTs for implementation purposes.

Software Development Agency, M/s Wipro Ltd. scope of work at the centre has provision of setting up a Helpdesk support to the State/UT SIs during customization, deployment and stabilization phases. During these phases (after delivering final version of CAS) SDA will deploy a team of qualified and certified resources in NCRB to address the questions from the SIs to support successful implementation of CAS in States/UTs.

It is again emphasised here that CAS - Lite offline version, which is now being shared on a CD with some necessary documentation with all States/Union Territories, is for study purpose only, so that States/UTs may familiarise themselves with the functionality, services and working of CAS. It should not be used for customization, configuration and implementation purpose.
