
Please refer to the subject stated above.

Sir/Madam,

This is in reference to the Process Advisory Group Meeting dated 29th June 2011 and decision taken on **Digitization of legacy data and real time data**. It has been decided that data digitization would be done in parallel for both legacy data & real time data.

The legacy data needs to be digitized for a period of 10 years. The cutoff date for calculating 10 years for which data has to be digitized as part of CCTNS project, would be calculated backward from the date when the CAS will be implemented in the state. The legacy data needs to be digitized in an order with 'most recent data to older data'.

States/ UTs are advised to comply with above decision while carrying out the digitization of legacy data. Moreover data digitization should be carried out in dual manner, ie, digitization of legacy data and digitization of real time data to run in parallel. This will help States/ UTs to overcome any lag with respect to consolidated data availability in CCTNS project.
