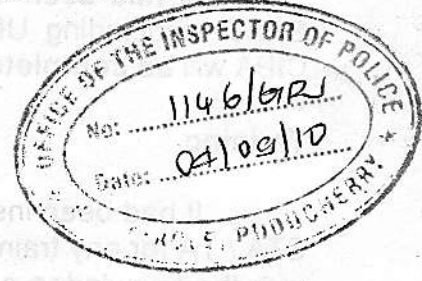

MINUTES OF THE CIPA MIS DEMO HELD ON 18.08.2010 AT 11.00 HRS

The CIPA MIS DEMO was held for the month of August 2010 on 18/08/2010 at 1100 hrs at the DGP Conference hall. The demo / meeting was chaired by the DGP, Puducherry. The following officers attended the demo.

Thiru. V. Gopi swaminathan, CIPA Co-ordinator, NIC gave a demo on MIS developed for CIPA data retrieval was shown to the participants in the presence of the DGP and other senior officers. Envisaging e-CRB, it had been explained that all the details entered by the Police Stations are immediately updated in the web-server at CRB. It was shown that the FIRs, Status of the cases, Search of complainant / accused / stolen vehicles, monthly reports, graphical analysis are available instant by period, stations, acts / section etc., for the entire UT and it can be added more to suit the requirement and the following points were discussed:-

A Rack-mount Server had been purchased by the department and installed in Computer Centre of CRB on 16/6/2010. NIC had installed all the necessary software and configured it as an Internet Server under the guidance of Open Technology Centre (OTC) of NIC, Chennai. Using the valid Static IP - Address (59.90.2.143) already obtained for the purpose. Out of the continuous efforts taken at both the ends till now 36 out of 38 Police stations are connected on-line with Web-Server at CRB (including Puducherry, Karaikal, Mahe and Yanam). The remaining Police stations will be completed after resolving the connectivity issues at PS level with respective BSNL Unit. For a support on 24 x 7 basis of the server, the infrastructural requirement like dedicated power supply, backup servers, connectivity between servers, manpower requirements, data security and disaster recovery plan may be worked out. A proposal to NIC for this is requested.

It was requested to have a dedicated UPS power supply for the server and as a temporary arrangement the 2 KVA UPS from Mangalam PS has been shifted and installed in Police Computer Centre.

The CIPA coordinator also informed that training on server side management customized for the CRB officials will be conducted on 20<sup>th</sup> and 21<sup>st</sup> September 2010 at Chennai. The participants list is required to be communicated to OTC, Chennai.

Data Entry Status

NIC coordinator for CIPA submitted that the CIPA data entry status along with the progress for all modules to the committee. The data entry status was reviewed by DGP and it was instructed to all SP's (N/S/R/T) to take necessary action for completing the pending data entry on all modules (FIRs / Investigation / Prosecution) and take regular backups of the data.

Warranty and AMC for CIPA systems:

It had been informed that the 3 years warranty period for all the Computer Systems including UPS and other accessories supplied to all Police Stations under CIPA will be completed by this year. A proposal has been sent to

Training

It had been instructed that CIPA operators of all Police stations may interact with STA / TA for any training requirements so that all Police stations have at least 2 officials with the knowledge on CIPA. The contact details of STA/TA were already provided to all Police stations.

General

DGP had opined that this effort will help the department for getting quick information from any Police Stations and appreciated the efforts of NIC.

During discussion DGP expressed that some more additional details such as cell phone number, IMEI number, council for the accused, etc to be made available from the CIPA system. In checking of vehicle details he had welcomed the suggestion of the NIC officials regarding connecting the RTO data base for checking the veracity of the vehicle details and had informed to check for the procedure to be followed in getting connected to RTO database. A letter in this regard will be communicated to RTO. He also informed to give a link in the Puducherry Police Website for checking the vehicle details.

He also expressed his unhappiness in the status of data entry in the CIPA. He instructed all the SDPOs/CIs/SHOs to carry out the data entry in a war footing manner and finish the backlog immediately. He also suggested looking for outsourcing of man power of data entry work. Inspector (CRB) / Circle Inspector (GB) was instructed to look out for the procedure for outsourcing. DGP had instructed Inspector (CRB) to submit the data entry status report on weekly basis to SSP(L&O) and requested SSP(L&O) to monitor the progress on weekly basis and report compliance.

In general all the SDPOs/CIs/SHOs expressed that no computer operator is there to feed the data and requested to post permanent operators. SSP(L&O) had instructed all the SDPOs to submit their requirements so as take any suitable action in this regard. He had requested NIC officials to give the list of trained personnel in CIPA, so that they can be put to optimum use in future.
