Sub : Constitution of User Group participation for Conference Room Pilot (CRP) under Crime and Criminal Tracking Network and Systems - reg.

Dear Sir,

The Crime and Criminal Tracking Network and Systems (CCTNS) was conceptualized by the Ministry of Home Affairs (MHA), Government of India in detailed consultations with all stakeholders. This is an improved version of earlier IT initiatives like Common Integrated Police Application (CIPA) and Crime Criminal Information System (CCIS) which were currently working as stand alone systems. The project was approved by the Cabinet Committee on Economic Affairs on 19th June, 2009, as a 100% centrally sponsored scheme with an outlay of Rs. 2000 Crores.

CCTNS aims at creating a comprehensive and integrated system for enhancing the efficiency and effective policing at all levels and especially at the Police Station level through adoption of principles of e-Governance. This project would create a nationwide networked infrastructure for investigation of crime and detection of criminals in real time. Hence the primary focus of CCTNS is to deliver value at the police station level with ability to view and exchange information amongst Police Stations, between States, with Centre and other Police Organizations and with external entities identified as a part of this project.

As you are already aware, the Software requirement specifications for development of Core application software (CAS) under CCTNS is underway. It is proposed that an identified group of end users of CCTNS would participate in the Conference Room Pilot (CRP), envisaged as an essential activity before the CAS application Software requirement specification (SRS) is completed and approved. The Software Development Agency (SDA, M/s Wipro Ltd), would conduct the CRP wherein they will prepare a comprehensive prototype to demonstrate the aspects of CAS.

The objective of the conference room pilot is to receive feedback from groups of end users on the specifications of the application. The users would be shown the proposed Graphical User Interface (GUI) design and navigation of application in a conference room setting.

The importance of this activity cannot be undermined as this would be one of the platforms through which the end user feedback would be sought before actual software development is started. The identified user group would test the prototype and the SDA will interact closely with the user groups and gather their inputs. The user inputs (across various levels) would be extremely vital at this stage of the CAS software development based on which the specifications of application would be finalized before SRS is frozen and design is started.

We request you to nominate one SP level Officer to participate in the discussions and help in developing a good quality software.

The participation of the nominated officers is important in the interest of your State and therefore your State may not go unrepresented as it is a critical step in the design and development of CAS for CCTNS. You may kindly pick and choose the officers who are having good understanding of Police functioning and processes, for this purpose.


These officials would spend 2 days in Delhi (20-21st October 2010) to brainstorm on the recommendations and the systems being designed by the SDA. We request you to kindly spare the services of the concerned officers for the period beginning from 20th October 2010 at 9:00 am onwards, so that the system being conceptualized meets the key requirements of the Police Department. You are also requested to provide their contacts along with the nominations. The venue would be intimated to the nominated officials as well as your kind self and the nodal officer, CCTNS as soon as it is finalized.

The recommendations of the committee would be very important to take policing to the next level and your personal intervention would be of great help.
