**NOTE**

Sub:- Report - CCTNS, Regional workshop for CCTNS Nodal Officer (Southern Region) held on 18<sup>th</sup> November 2009 at CID Complex, Bangalore.

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As directed by DGP, Puducherry the undersigned along with S. Bascarane, Inspector of Police (GB Circle) have attended the meeting cited above.

The meeting was convened at CID Complex, Bangalore on 18.11.09 at 10.50 hrs headed by Shri. Rajiv Mathur, IPS DG, NCRB, New Delhi, in the presence of Tvl. Ajai Kumar Singh, DG & IGP, Karnataka and PRK. Naidu, Joint Director, NCRB, New Delhi. The meeting was attended by a team from National Institute of Smart Governance (NISG) represented by the members of Price Water Works Coopers, who are acting as the nodal body for CCTNS Project at NCRB, New Delhi.



As scheduled representatives from the States / UTs of Southern Region attending the meeting and briefed their status. During the meeting the status of Puducherry on implementation of CCTNS was clearly briefed as decided by DGP and DIG. The following are the various issues raised in the meeting.

1. SPMC list will be finalized soon and the list will be communicated to all.
2. Standards for hardware and software will be centralized and it will be communicated.
3. Centralization of secondary connectivity to be discussed at NCRB / MHA apart from BSNL broad band.
4. CIPA is being subsumed into CCTNS and NIC will act as a consultant and advisor. NIC is to advice and to peruse the documentations. It will locally assist in the implementation and migration of CIPA data to CCTNS.
5. No special cadre can be created for the purpose of CCTNS / CIPA. As part of e-governance and modernization, Recruitment Rules for all ranks shall be incorporated with knowledge of computer as basic requirements for all levels.
6. SPMC will prepare implementation plan by discussing on various issues inclusive of digitization of records and connected instrumentation to be executed through SI.

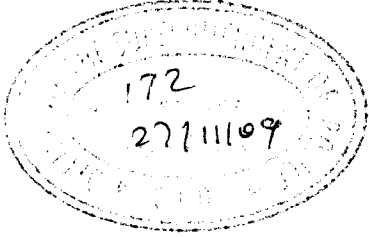
7. Funds required for other police stations not incorporated in this sanction issued. The same was projected by the other states especially by IGP, Tamilnadu. It was advised to project it with SPMC and SI to incorporate for even distribution within the fund and the empowered committee shall take the decision as the fund is restricted or the State / UT funds can be utilized.
8. For spending of allotted funds, SI will project the cost before the State / UT Empowered Committee which will discuss and approve. Then the committee will pass the orders to SDA who will in turn release fund.
9. No fund is allotted to hire or create staff strength. However the state / UT will utilize their existing staff of the SDA for office maintenance or they can use their state fund for the above purpose.
10. Individual ID to all Police Personnel and the nature of ID will be discussed at NCRB.
11. It was advised to write to JS (UT), MHA and NCRB, New Delhi for any clarification sought with regard to more funds or creation of staff or additions if any required.
12. Minutes of the meeting will be sent to all after consolidation by NCRB.

24. Sir submitted, the identified points are @clarified as follows.

Point C: It represents the connectivity network that is under progress in PSWAN by IT & NIC  
Vs connectivity network under CCTNS for broadband inclusion.

Point D: <sup>brood band</sup> of connectivity in BSNL fails then the system will remain standstill. So an alternative connectivity for brood band is essential. The same was stressed by ~~Dr. Computer, TN~~, other Southern Region states like TN, Kerala etc and it was also suggested to have the model connectivity from all service providers which can hunt to the available connectivity so that network connectivity under CCTNS remains ~~other~~ alive even if one or other connectivity of any service provider (BSNL, Airtel, Reliance, Aircel) goes off/repair/problem. Hence we have requested to suggest for alternative connectivity.

Point E: As directed and advised by DIG, the point of standardization of Hardware & Software was requested before DIG, NCRB & the model agent NISG ~~(NCRB)~~ and it was agreed but requested us to send proposal/clarification, so that the purchase of Computers, accessories, networking equipments shall be purchased as specified without any future comments on it.
