



## **PRESS NOTE**

The Passing-Out Parade of XIX-Batch Recruit Police Constables is held today (02.04.2011) at 07.00 Hrs. at Police Stadium, Gorimedu, Puducherry. Dr. Iqbal Singh, His Excellency the Lt. Governor of Puducherry is the Chief Guest and the function is held in the presence of Thiru. R. Chandramohan, IAS, Chief Secretary to Government of Puducherry and Thiru. J.K. Sharma, IPS, Inspector General of Police, Tvl. I.D. Shukla, IPS, Dy. Inspector General of Police, Atul Katyar, IPS, SSP(L&O), V.J. Chandiran, PPS, SSP(HQ), Anto Alphonse, IPS, SSP(Incharge, C&I) and other Police Officers are also participating.

168 Recruit Police Constables including 5 Women Recruit Police Constables are Passed-Out today. This Ceremonial function is held to mark the conclusion of their nine months basic training held at Police Training School, Gorimedu, Puducherry. This occasion is also considered to be a solemn occasion for the Recruit Police Constables as it is the first step taken by them to move forward in service as a full-fledged constables.

Most of the above Recruit Police Constables were previously employed as Home Guards and they have been absorbed as Police Constables based on reservation of 25% for Home Guards in the Recruitment of Police Constables.

The above Recruit Police Constables were given basic training in Outdoor subjects like Physical Training, Squad Drill, Arms Drill, Lathi Drill, Crowd Control, Weapon Tactics, Firing, Yoga, First Aid and Handling of Wireless, etc. In Indoor training, they were taught the provisions of Law in Modern India and Role of Police, Police Administration and Organisation, Criminology, Police Science, Indian Penal Code, Criminal Procedure Code, Indian Evidence Act, Special and Local Laws, Police Duties, Police Procedures, Computer Application and Human Rights. After conclusion of the training, examinations were conducted for them in Indoor and Outdoor subject. The following persons were stood first in the following ten Indoor subjects and they are given cash reward of Rs. 500/- and Commendation Certificates each.
